

Instructions - Patient Room Photo Pocket

Because you received this kit, know our hearts are with you and your loved one admitted into a Healthcare Facility. The enclosed photo pocket can be hung in their room and will tell their story when you cannot be there to do it. This has proven helpful for patients who are non-verbal, in an isolation unit with no visitation or have special needs.

Use the example and instructions below to complete your photo pocket. Our hope is this will encourage your loved one when they see it as well as tell their story to the doctors and nurses working to heal them.

1. Complete the enclosed 8 x 10 Patient Contact Information Card and insert as shown below
2. Insert photos into every other pocket as show below. We recommend at least one 8 x 10 photo so the patient can easily see it from their bed. We also recommend some photos be as recent as possible.
3. Fill out the enclosed 5 x 7 Who I Am Cards to explain what is in the photos and to tell the Doctors and Nurses about your loved one. What are their hobbies/interests? Are they married? Do they have kids, grandchildren or pets? Where are they from? Once completed insert as shown below.
4. Return to the Healthcare Facility so they can hang it in their patient room
